# C to Kerala: Why not crack down trade unions breaking the law?

Investors are afraid Kerala due to 'nukkukooli'. The High Court said while asking the government why it is against trade unions who take law hands.

Devan Rama questioned the govt's claim that the investor-friendly considering a petition by TK Sundaresan

of Anchal in Kollam, seeking police protection against trade union workers demanding 'nukkukooli'.

Nokkukooli, loosely translated from Malayalam as 'gawking wages,' is the practice of trade unions in Kerala to demand payment for work they have not done. Head-load workers, who prevent loading or unloading of goods if they are not obliged, generally engage in nokkukooli. Nokkukooli reached the level of extortion during

the 80s and 90s, the heyday of trade union militancy, but subsided thereafter.

During the hearing, the court said, "It's not enough to claim that Kerala is an investment-friendly state, we have to live up to it. Why is the government not initiating action against trade unions taking the law into their hands? I don't understand the hesitation. If this goes on, no one will be ready to invest in the state."

The court also referred to

the issue over demand for 'nukkukooli' by union workers with regard to ISRO's heavy goods at Thiruvananthapuram and said such incidents result in humiliation for the state. Despite bringing in a ban on 'nukkukooli' a decade ago, it has not been implemented yet, the court pointed out. The court also added that the fear among people to invest in Kerala is the primary reason for fewer employment opportunities in the state.
